To Parent or Guardian:

In order to provide the best educational experience, school personnel must understand your child's health needs. This form requests information from you (Part 1) which will also be helpful to the health care provider when he or she completes the medical evaluation (Part 2) and the oral assessment (Part 3).

State law requires complete primary immunizations and a health assessment by a legally qualified practitioner of medicine, an advanced practice registered nurse or registered nurse, licensed pursuant to chapter 378, a physi-

cian assistant, licensed pursuant to chapter 370, a school medical advisor, or a legally qualified practitioner of medicine, an advanced practice registered nurse or a physician assistant stationed at any military base prior to school entrance in Connecticut (C.G.S. Secs. 10-204a and 10-206). An immunization update and additional health assessments are required in the 6th or 7th grade and in the 9th or 10th grade. Specific grade level will be determined by the local board of education. This form may also be used for health assessments required every year for students participating on sports teams.

To Parent(s) or Guardian(s):

State law requires that each local board of education request that an oral health assessment be conducted prior to public school enrollment, in either grade six or grade seven, and in either grade nine or grade ten (Public Act No. 18-168). The specific grade levels will be determined by the local board of education. The oral health assessment shall include a dental examination by a dentist or a visual screening and risk assessment for oral health conditions by a dental hygienist, or by a legally qualified practitioner of medicine, physician assistant or advanced practice registered nurse who has been trained in conducting an oral health assessment as part of a training program approved by the Commissioner of Public Health.

KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 6

 DTaP: At least 4 doses, with the final dose on or after the 4th birthday; students who start the series at age 7 or older only need a total of 3 doses of tetanus-diphtheria containing vaccine.

- Polio: At least 3 doses, with the final dose on or after the 4th birthday.
- MMR: 2 doses at least 28 days apart, with the 1st dose on or after the 1st birthday.
- Hib: 1 dose on or after the st birthday (children 5 years and older do not need proof of vaccination).
- Pneumococcal: 1 dose on or after the 1st birthday (children 5 years and older do not need proof of vaccination).
- Hep A: 2 doses given six months apart, with the 1st dose on or after the 1st birthday.

- Hep B: 3 doses, with the final dose on or after 24 weeks of age.
- Varicella: 2 doses, with the 1st dose on or after the1st birthday or verification of disease.**

GRADES 7 THROUGH 12

- Tdap/Td: 1 dose of Tdap required for students who completed their primary DTaP series; for students who start the series at age 7 or older a total of 3 doses of tetanus-diphtheria containing vaccines are required, one of which must be Tdap.
- Polio: At least 3 doses, with the final dose on or after the 4th birthday.
- MMR: 2 doses at least 28 days apart, with the 1st dose on or after the 1st birthday.
- · Meningococcal: 1 dose
- Hep B: 3 doses, with the final dose on or after 24 weeks of age.
- Varicella: 2 doses, with the 1st dose on or after the 1st birthday or verification of disease.**
- Hep A: 2 doses given six months apart, with the 1st dose on or after the 1st birthday.

- · August 1, 2017: Pre-K through 5th grade
- · August 1, 2018: Pre-K through 6th grade
- August 1, 2019: Pre-K through 7th grade
- August 1, 2020: Pre-K through 8th grade
- August 1, 2021: Pre-K through 9th grade
- August 1, 2022: Pre-K through 10th grade
- August 1, 2023: Pre-K through 11th grade
- August 1, 2024: Pre-K through 12th grade
- ** Verification of disease: Confirmation in writing by an MD, PA, or APRN that the child has a previous history of disease, based on family or medical history.

Note: The Commissioner of Public Health may issue a temporary waiver to the schedule for active immunization for any vaccine if the National Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recognizes a nationwide shortage of supply for such vaccine.
